### **Our Services**



Reference should be made to the Regulations for the precise scope of each service and this schedule must be read within the context of the Regulations as a whole.

- Co-operate with others working on the project.
- · Report to the Client.
- Provide timely information or instructions.
- Plan, manage and monitor the pre-construction phase.
- Take into account the general principles of prevention.
- Identify, eliminate or control foreseeable risks to health and safety of any person during construction, maintenance and use of the building.
- Ensure all other Client Appointments comply with their duties under the CDM Regulations 2015.
- Ensure that all persons working in relation to the Pre-

- construction Phase co-operate with all other Client Appointments, regarding health and safety.
- Assist the Client in the provision of the Pre-Construction information.
- Liaise with the Principal Contractor.
- Assist the Principal Contractor in preparing the Construction Phase plan.
- Prepare a Health and Safety File.
- Ensure that the Health and Safety File is reviewed, updated and revised during the period of appointment.
- Pass the Health and Safety File to the Client at the end of the Project.

### Our Method

Example of a typical CDM Matrix, which is adopted for all projects to identify hazards and significant risks, with a view to mitigation during the design process. This matrix is used as a tool throughout the project and is reviewed at key stages using a traffic light approval system.














